Benwood, City of-Sys Improvements III (new application)

Jason Billups described the request, and it is technically feasible.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the City of Benwood pursue a \$2,000,000 CWSRF Debt Forgiveness Loan, a \$750,000 WDA EEGF, and a \$1,000,000 IJDC Grant for an estimated project cost of \$3,750,000.

Jason Billups moved that the recommendation be approved, Jonathan Fowler seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the Town of Davy pursue a \$3,000,000 ARC Grant, a \$2,000,000 CDBG (SCBG), a \$2,000,000 CWSRF Debt Forgiveness Loan, a \$589,000 CDS, a \$50,000 McDowell County Commission Grant, and a \$1,000,000 IJDC Grant for an estimated project cost of \$8,639,000.

Jason Billups moved that the recommendation be approved, Jonathan Fowler seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Harrisville, Town of-WWTP Improvements (new application)

Jason Billups described the request, and it is technically feasible.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the Town of Harrisville, pursue a \$1,500,000 CWSRF Principal Forgiveness, a \$340,000 CWSRF Loan (2%, 30 yrs., 0.25 AF), a \$700,000 Harisville ARPA Grant, a \$100,000 Ritchie County ARPA Grant, a \$785,000 WDA EEGF, and a \$500,000 IJDC Grant for an estimated project cost of \$3,925,000.

Jason Billups moved that the recommendation be approved, Jonathan Fowler seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Hendricks, Town of-Storm Sewer Improvements (new application)

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the Town of Hendricks pursue \$1,621,000 WDA EEGF and a \$108,000 Hendricks ARPA Grant for an estimated project cost of \$1,729,000.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the Kanawha Falls PSD pursue a \$9,456,750 FEMA Grant and a \$1,500,000 CWSRF Debt Forgiveness Loan and a \$1,652,250 WDA EEGF for an estimated project cost of \$12,609,000.

Jason Billups moved that the recommendation be approved, Jonathan Fowler seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends Mason County PSD pursue a \$975,000 US ACE Grant, a \$162,500 IJDC Economic Development Grant, a \$162,500 AEP/Private Grant, a \$8,000,000 Governor's Appropriation, a \$5,915,000 Governor's Appropriation, a \$1,500,000 CWSRF Debt Forgiveness, a \$5,324,217 US EDA Grant, a \$1,000,000 CDS Grant, a \$960,783 WDA EEGF, and a \$1,000,000 IJDC Grant for an estimated project cost of \$25,000,000.
