IJDC Project - 2022W-2154 Slanesville Water Project Use of Contingency Request

RECOMMENDATION

The use of contingency request submitted by Region 8 Planning & Development Council and Cerrone Associates, Inc., for the above referenced project has been reviewed and is technically feasible.

DISCUSSION

The Central Hampshire PSD is requesting \$139,760.19 of contingency funds for the following uses; \$11,000 for additional Project Inspection, \$22,000 for Additional Services and \$106,760.19 for Contract 2 Change order work.

Change Order 1 for Contract 2 provides compensation for the installation of a master meter and vault for the Slanesville Extensions and the purchase of 125 additional replacement meters. The master meter and additional replacement meters are a request of the PSD. Change Order 1 totals \$106,760.19.

There was a several week delay during the directional drill under Little Cacapon River, which expanded the existing inspection budget. \$11,000 for additional Project Inspection is being requested. Additional Services were required by Cerrone Associates to secure a storage tank site

and work with landowners legal representation. \$22,000 is being requested for this additional work. Both of these items include the anticipated costs to complete the project.

Contract 1 (Water Line Extensions) is substantially complete and Contract 2 (Water Storage Tank) has issued a partial substantial completion. Contract 2 work remaining includes telemetry and chlorine building and the work associated with Change Order #1. \$12,644.24 will remain in Construction Contingency following the approval of this request. The available contingency should be adequate to complete all the contracted projects.
